

CHUBBY CARRIER AND THE BAYOU SWAMP BAND

BAND RIDER

THIS RIDER IS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE AGREEMENT. *You do not need to sign this rider. By signing the attached contract, you agree to the terms of this rider.*

BILLING: When headlining, Chubby Carrier and the Bayou Swamp Band shall receive 100% star billing on all advertising and publicity pertaining to the engagement. When not headlining, Chubby Carrier and the Bayou Swamp Band shall receive 100% guest star billing (60% type size) in ALL advertising and publicity.

LOAD IN: Management shall provide access to the venue a minimum of two (2) hours prior to the house opening to the public. All sound and lighting personnel and equipment shall be operational at this time. **Purchaser shall provide three (3) stagehands to assist with load in, set up and load out.** Stagehands should be at venue when band arrives and available until after load out is completed.

SOUND AND LIGHTING: All sound and light expenses shall be paid by promoter. Sound system must be adequate for venue and equipped for five pieces on stage. Promoter shall make available one person to set up soundboard and one person to work the lighting console or monitor board. See stage plot for set up. Band prefers a 24 channel board whenever possible. ON CLUB DATES, ARTIST PREFERS THAT THE HOUSE SOUND SYSTEM HAVE THREE MONITOR MIXES.

DRESSING ROOM: Promoter agrees to provide one dry, lockable, secure room for use by five band personnel. Dressing room will include two 110-volt electrical outlets, mirror and five clean, dry towels. No unauthorized persons will be admitted to dressing room.

REFRESHMENTS: The following shall be provided at promoter's expense. HOT meals for five people or a \$15.00 per diem for five. The following shall also be provided: Water, soft drinks, and HOT tea.

LIVE RECORDING: Promoter shall not permit audio or video recording or filming of Chubby Carrier and the Bayou Swamp Band's performance without prior written consent by the artist.

MERCHANDISING: Chubby Carrier reserves the sole right to sell merchandise pertaining to the artist. This may include, but is not limited to, CDs, DVDs, T-shirts, buttons, stickers, etc. Chubby Carrier shall retain 100% of revenue and therefore is not liable to pay any percentage of merchandise sales to the house.
